Virtual Laboratory for the creation and operation of a simulated formative company in Vocational Education and Training

Acronimo: VET-L@B

Descrizione sintetica del progetto (in inglese):

The project aims to create a virtual laboratory (VET-L@B) in which the students and their teachers are involved in running a company for educational aims to experiment roles and tasks which are typical of the working field, breaking the cycle of no skills no jobs. The simulator requires that the game takes place online, where are those who run the company and those who are customers. The virtual learning environment is thus both in the individual school or in the wider market.

The VET-L@B integrates ICT-based content, services, pedagogies and practice into the curriculum of the school partners and in the education and training institutions which will apply this educational model in the future. The VET-L@B has the goal of "educating" the students not only in "accountancy", but also in digital competence and literature, entrepreneurial skills, using tools, methodologies and ICT-based content. For this reason, after a careful analysis by partners, it was chosen to simulate a territorial marketing agency, which is found to be the type of company that can combine into a single training process the different contents of school subjects with an approach able to relate the "local" and the "global" social and economic contexts.

The Consortium that applies for the proposal is made by 15 partners: applicant organization, a sectoral training provider, 4 associations, that represent non-state school and vocational centers, 1 university, 1 software-house, 8 among general, technical and vocational secondary schools.

The partners of the Consortium are from 6 European countries (UK, France, Spain, Italy, Austria and Hungary) and 1 third country (Egypt). The project involves two associated partners.

In terms of impact, the project will involve 8 general, technical and vocational secondary schools for a total of 180 teachers and trainers, and about 700 students, all interested in the implementation in class of the simulated formative territorial marketing agency.
